

How Is My Utility Bill Calculated?

Do you know how your monthly utility bill is calculated?

You are charged a monthly base fee for both water and sewer plus the user charge per 1000 gallons. Your sewer charge is based on the amount of gallons of water that you use.

Water Example:

Current Monthly Base Fee: \$18.70

Current User Fee per 1000 Gal. \$15.66

If you use 3,500 gallons of water:

Base Fee: **\$18.70***

User Fee:

3,500 subtract the first 500 gallons = 3,000 (3.000) x \$15.66 =
\$46.98*

Total Water Fee on your bill is \$18.70* + \$46.98* = **\$65.68**

Sewer Example:

Current Monthly Base Fee: \$19.80

Current User Fee per 1000 Gal.: \$ 6.57

If you use 3,500 gallons of water:

Base Fee: **\$19.80***

User Fee:

3,500 subtract the first 500 gallons = 3,000 (3.000) x \$ 6.57 =
\$19.71*

Total Water Fee on your bill is \$19.80* + \$19.71* = **\$39.51**
